RAILENIUM intends to be a reference center for Europe, bringing together all major railway players in Europe. With strong growth prospects for rail infrastructure, the opening of the market to competition, the need to control the costs and to ensure a sustainable development of the network, RAILENIUM will contribute to a more competitive and environment friendly rail service. As of today, RAILENIUM involves 7 research agencies and 18 companies (including manufacturers, constructors, infrastructure managers, engineering companies...) and is meant to attract other European partners and relevant stakeholders.
