

> University Diploma in French as a Foreign Language



If you don't speak a lot of French and would like to attain the level necessary to pursue your university studies in France and communicate with ease, this course is for you.

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What is the DUFLE?

The DUFLE is a year-long intensive linguistic course spread over 450 hours. The focus is on learning in a French-speaking environment, and helping students work progressively taking into account various aspects of the language.

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Objectives

- Acquiring linguistic, communication as well as culture-specific skills in order to facilitate everyday, social, academic and professional life in France.
 - Progressing from the B1 to B2 level as per the scale established by the Council of Europe.
 - Getting familiar with university departments, for those who'd like to pursue their studies at the Université Polytechnique Hauts-de-France after a year of DUFLE.
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Course contents

The DUFLE includes six modules taught by professionals recognized in the domain of FLE:

- **Module 1** : Written and spoken communication
 - **Module 2** : Grammatical aspects of the French language
 - **Module 3** : Written and spoken argumentation
 - **Module 4** : Specialized French courses
 - **Module 5** : Training for the TCF language test
 - **Module 6** : Civilization
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Working method

- The classes revolve around tried and tested teaching methods, using the communicative approach.
- The Centre de Ressources en Langues (Language Resource Centre) proposes various multimedia resources conducive to self-study, at the disposal of students.
- Conversation workshops are organized at the CRL.
- A possible integration is envisaged in certain university courses that students would like to pursue.
