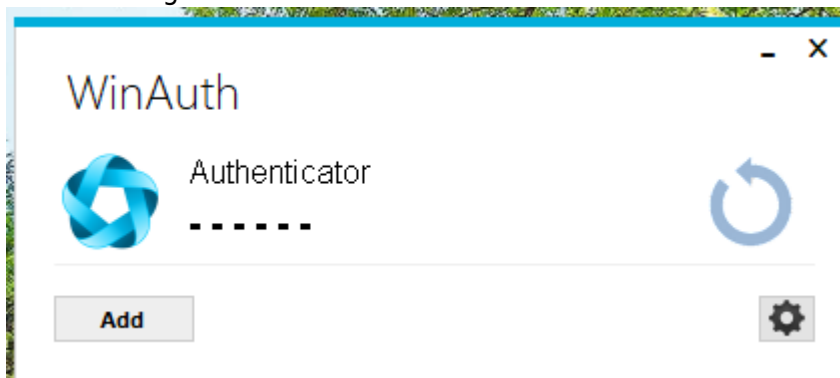


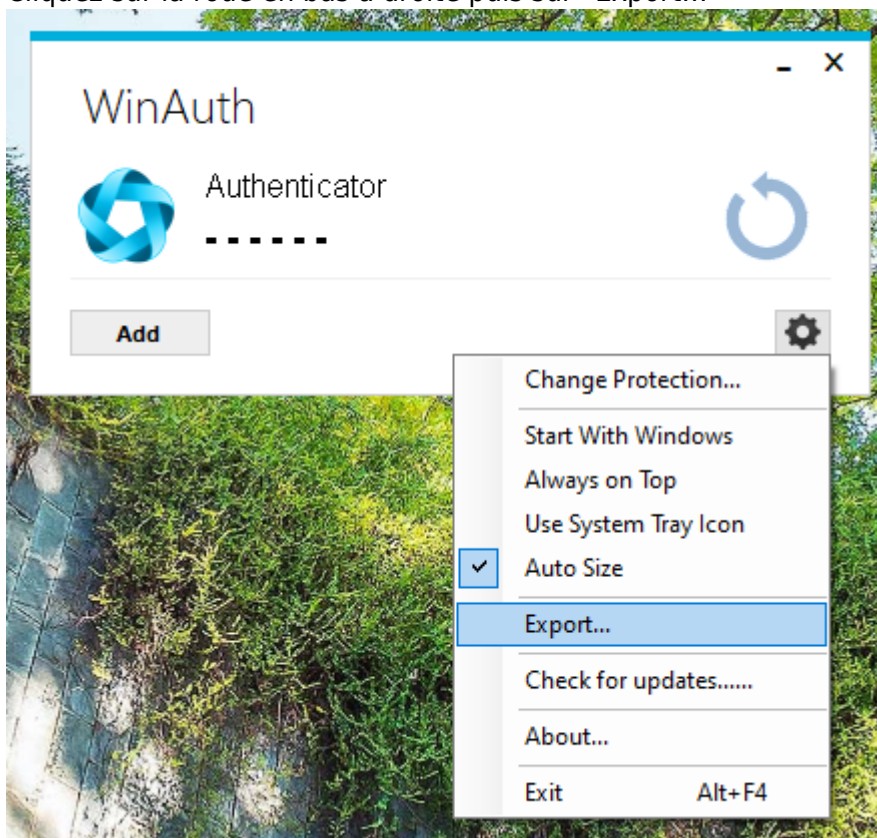
Sauvegarde et restauration de vos données de configuration MFA - Winauth

Exporter vos clefs

1. Lancez le logiciel Winauth



2. Cliquez sur la roue en bas à droite puis sur "Export..."



3. Sur cette fenêtre, cliquez directement sur "Browse ...":

Export

This will export a text file with an authenticator per line in Google's KeyUriFormat that can be imported into WinAuth or some other authenticator applications.

or **Browse for the PGP key file...**

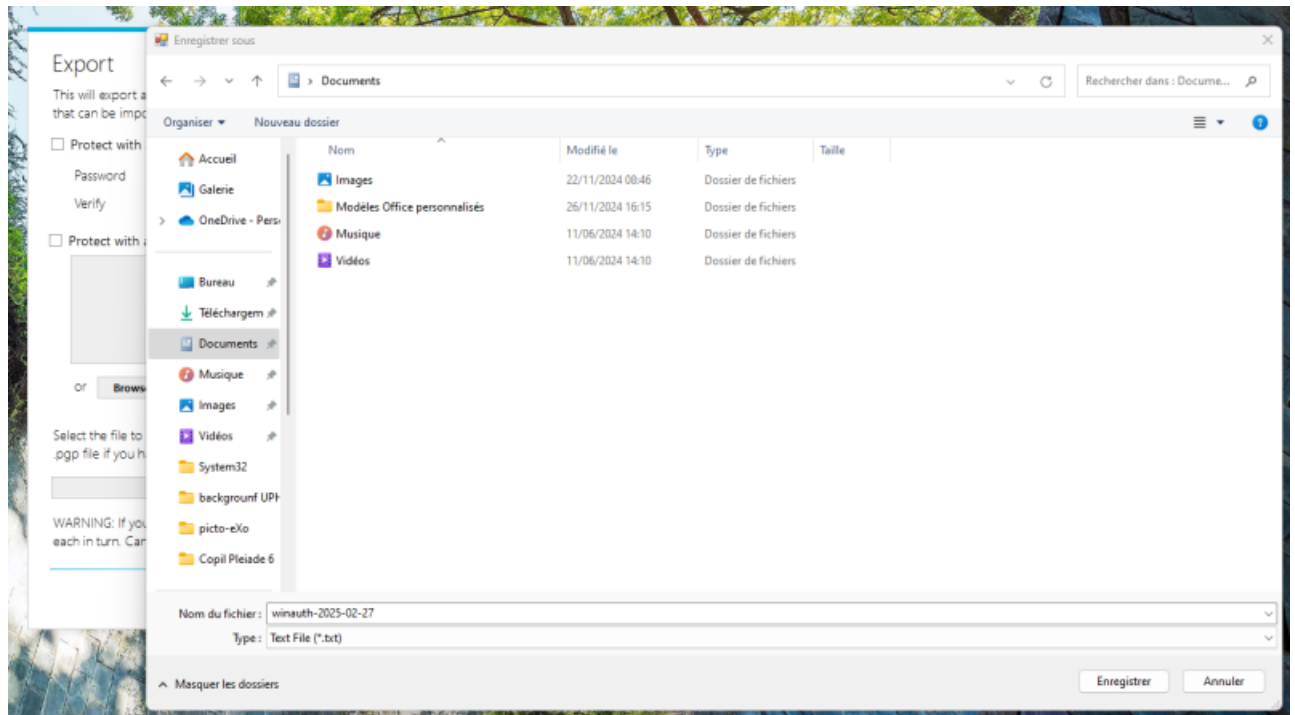
Select the file to be saved. This will be a ".zip" file if you have used a password, a .pgp file if you have used a PGP key, otherwise a plain .txt file

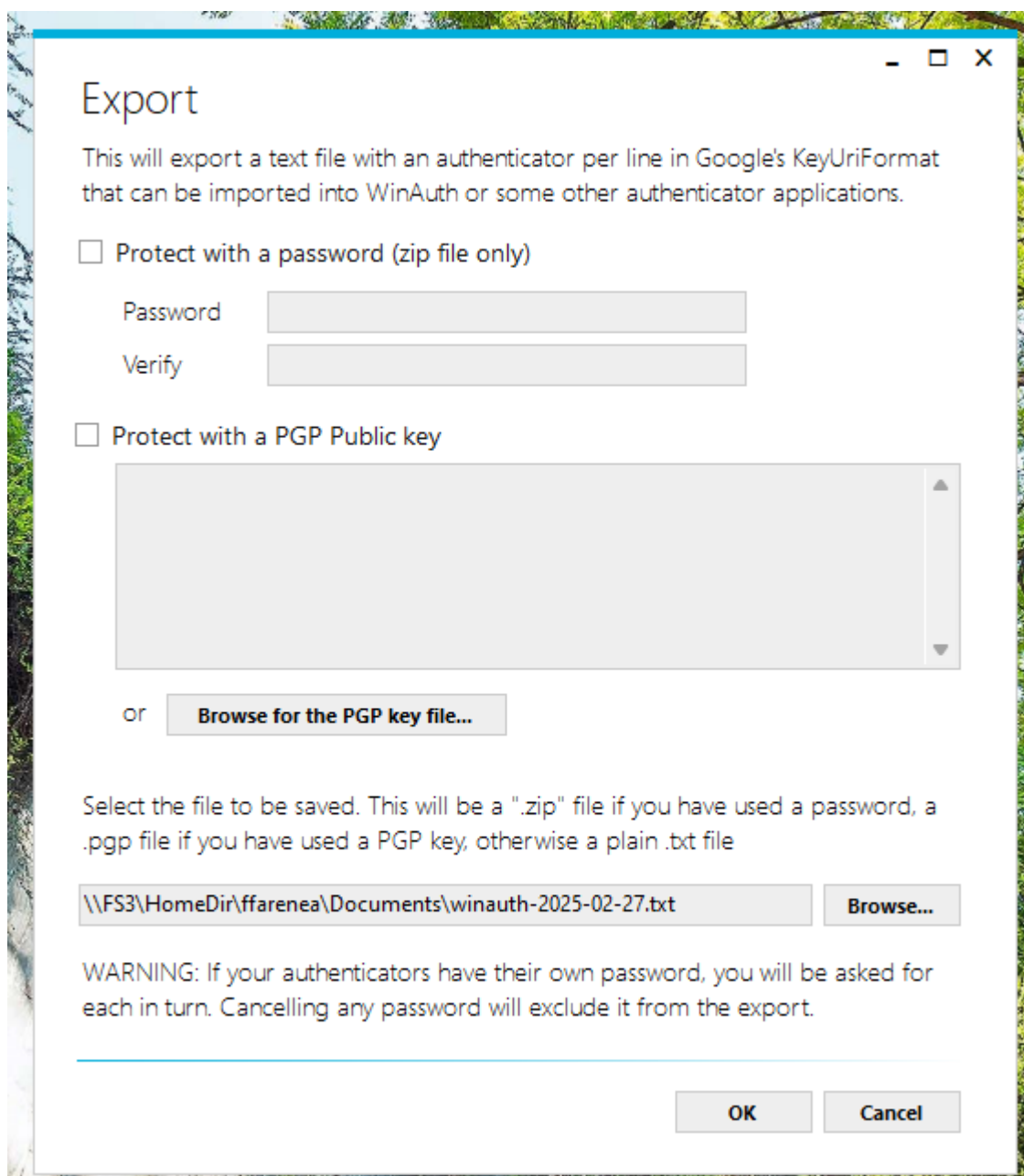
WARNING: If your authenticators have their own password, you will be asked for each in turn. Cancelling any password will exclude it from the export.

5. L'interface d'export apparaît comme suit



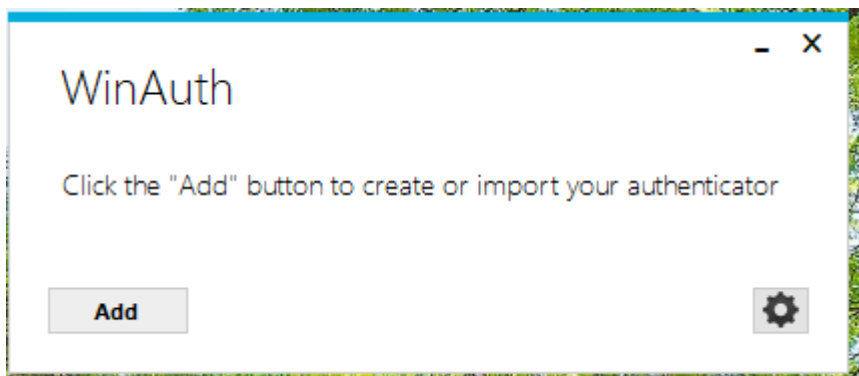
6. Cliquez sur "ok"

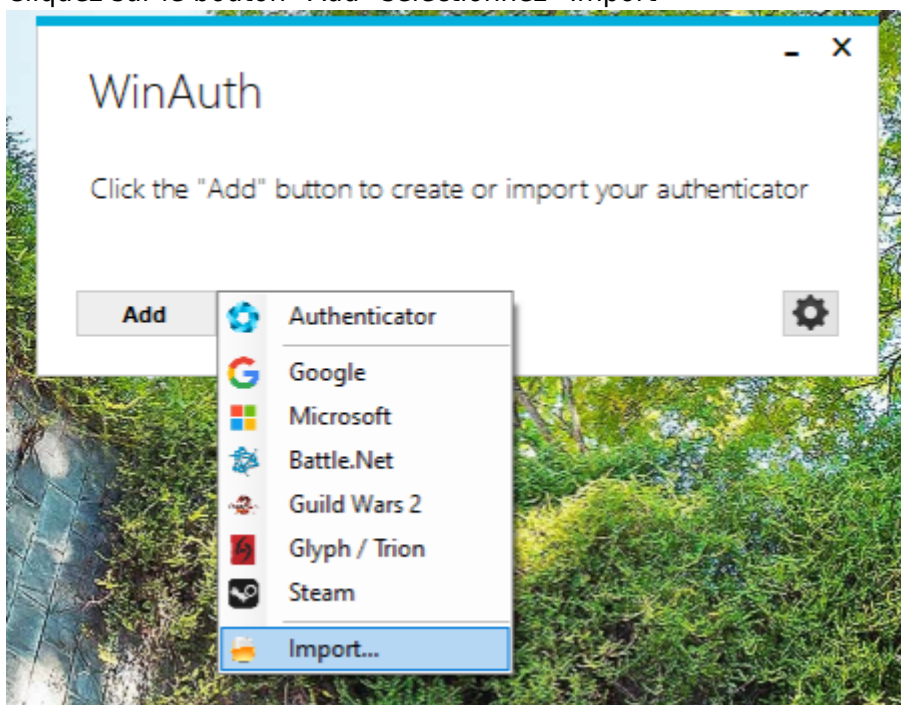

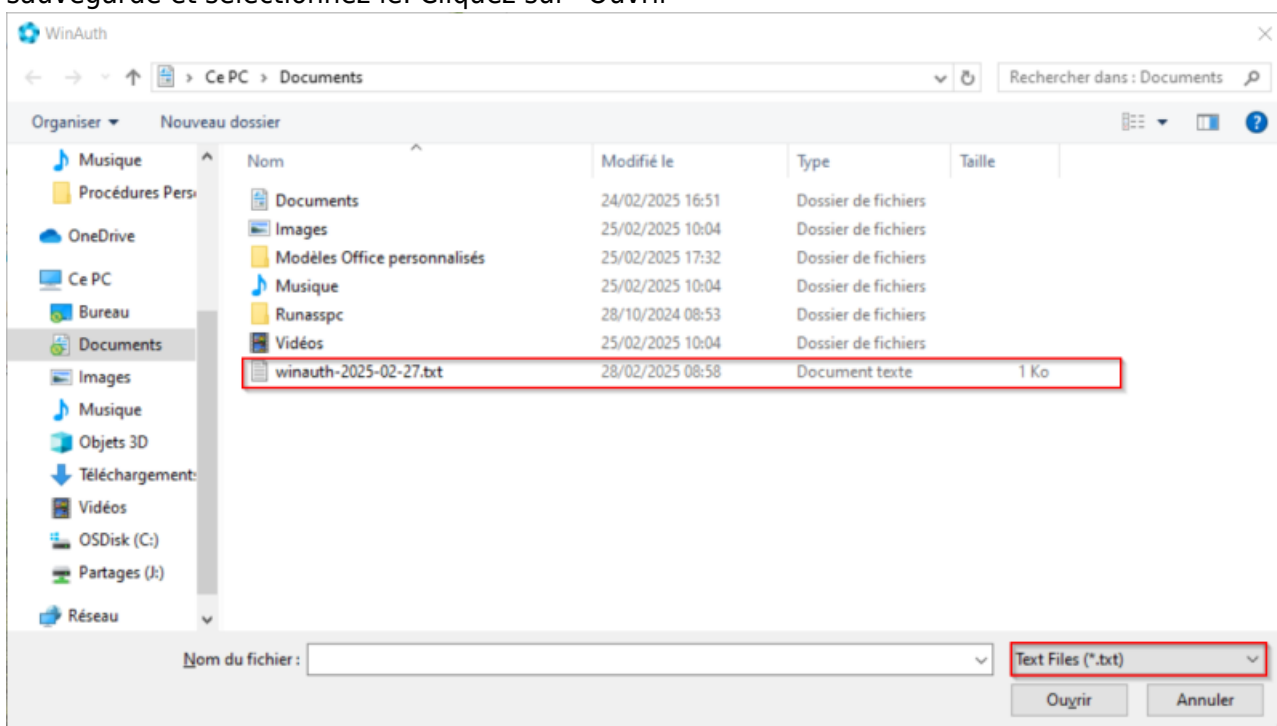
1. Lancez le logiciel Winauth



2. Cliquez sur le bouton "Add" sélectionnez "Import"



3. Retournez dans "Mes Documents" et modifiez à l'aide du menu déroulant en bas à droite de la fenêtre "WinAuth Files (*.xml)" vers "Text Files (*.txt)" afin de voir apparaître votre fichier préalablement sauvegardé et sélectionnez le. Cliquez sur "Ouvrir"



4. Décochez "Protect with my own password" puis cliquez sur "OK"

Protection

Select how you would like to protect your authenticators. Using a password is strongly recommended, otherwise your data could be read and stolen by malware running on your computer.

☐ **Protect with my own password**

Your authenticators will be encrypted using your own password and you will need to enter your password to open WinAuth. Your authenticators will be inaccessible if you forget your password and you do not have a backup.

Additionally, you can protect and encrypt your data using the built-in Windows account encryption. This will lock your authenticators to this computer or user so they cannot be opened even if the files are copied. You MUST turn this off if you are going to reformat your disk, re-install Windows or delete this user account.

☐ Encrypt to only be useable on this computer

☐ And only by the current user on this computer

☐ **Lock with a YubiKey**

Your YubiKey must support Challenge-Response using HMAC-SHA1 in one of its slots. Use the YubiKey personalization tool to configure the slot or click the Configure Slot button.
